

NOTICE

TO ALL EMPLOYEES OCCUPYING POSITIONS IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE OF JEFFERSON COUNTY AND THE JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH

A law (No. 248, H 580) enacted by the Legislature of Alabama Regular Session 1945, approved by the Governor on July 6, 1945, and amended by Act No. 476 of the 1957 Legislature, and by Act No. 591 of the 1957 Legislature, provides that the occupant of a position in the Classified service of Jefferson County, including employees of the County Board of Health, shall be elected to serve as a member of the Citizens Supervisory Commission, said member to be elected by the Classified Employees of Jefferson County, and the Employees of the County Board of Health. The one-year term will commence on November 1, 2011 and end on October 31, 2012. There are two meetings a year, the third Tuesday in November and May, at noon.
