2008-2009 Annual Classification Survey Update



The Survey which began July 1, 2008 is coming to a close. The Classification and Compensation Department completed desk audits on January 31, 2009. The purpose of the audit was to clarify any additional duties or responsibilities that were outlined in the Position Description Questionnaire (PDQ) and follow up on information that was not clear. Therefore, all positions were not audited. This year 22% of the PDQs that were submitted had a desk audit.
